






**Venue Layout**

#### **SHIPPING**

Download the Shipping Guidelines: <a href="https://robosub.org/2023#resources">https://robosub.org/2023#resources</a>.

- Teams may ship their equipment to our conference hotels (Holiday Inn Bayside or The Dana on Mission Bay) as long as they will be able to pick the shipment up by Monday, July 31.
- Shipments cannot arrive at hotels prior to July 28.
- Shipment must be shipped out before the team leaves (no later than August 7).
- Use the Inbound Shipping Label (in the Shipping Guidelines) for the hotel where you have a reservation.
- Use the Outbound Shipping Label (in the Shipping Guidelines) using the address of the hotel where you have a reservation or drop your crate off with your shipper directly.
- Start now on planning on your outbound shipping arrangements now! Batteries are exceptionally difficult to ship.







#### Oh for Crying Out Loud | Coin Flip

  - 90° or 180° from dock





**Destination |** Gate




- Choose your destination

  - With Style
    - 10 ft/3 m before/after gate
    - Extra points
      - Every 90° change in orientation
        - Yaw: +100
        - Roll/Pitch: +200
      - Up to 800 points




#### Start Dialing | Buoy

• Buoy is two sided











Abydos Earth

- Place marker in correct bin for your destination


#### Goa'uld Attack | Torpedoes

- A pinger is used to find this task






#### Engaging Chevrons | Octagon






- 4 "chevrons" in the center.

#### Practice & Qualification

- Practice days: Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday
  - Qualification
    - Each vehicle must autonomously pass through one of the gates (A,B,C,D)
      - This gets you two semi-final runs
      - Teams that have pre-qualified don't need to do this
- Time Slots
  - 0700 to 1800 (7a to 6p, last run 1730)
  - 30mins in length (includes getting your vehicle in/out of the water)
    - The easier it is to hook up, the longer you have in the water
  - Sign up for any ONE time slot on site
    - You can sign up for another slot when your vehicle is lifted out of the water
  - Early morning time slot lottery
    - Meet at 0630, put your name in a hat. When you name is called, sign up for a time slot
    - Only need one team member






#### Semi-finals (Friday & Saturday)


- Move course A & B around
  - Each team in the semi-finals will have one run on A, and one on B
- C & D still open for practice for everyone
- Wild cards
  - Teams that did not qualify during the practice days can still qualify for a semi-final run
    - Just do **everything** necessary to qualify, and you can sign up for a wild card slot for that day
    - You have to do it all over again on the second day for a second semifinal run
- Score: Last run
  - Stop the clock when retrieving the vehicle (modified for multi-vehicles in the water)
  - Best of the two runs



#### Finals (Sunday)

- Combine A&B and streeeeeech out the course
  - Teams in the finals will get a practice run on the course in the morning
    - Shift the course for the official finals
  - · One Wild card
- Third Chance
  - Teams not in the finals will have an opportunity to run on the practice side for points
  - If the highest scoring team is above a given point threshold, they will get the wild-card slot for the finals
- Score: Best run
  - Free running clock


