SHIPPING

Review the Shipping Guidelines: <u>robosub.org/handbook</u>

- Teams may ship their equipment to the conference hotel (Hilton Irvine / Orange County Airport).
- IMPORTANT DATES
 - JULY 29 Shipments cannot arrive at hotels prior to July 29.
 - AUGUST 5 All shipments must be picked up by August 5.
 - AUGUST 14 Shipments must be shipped out before the team leaves California (no later than August 14).
- Use the Inbound Shipping Label (in the Shipping Guidelines) for the hotel where you have a reservation.
- Use the Outbound Shipping Label (in the Shipping Guidelines) using the address of the hotel where you have a reservation or drop your crate off with your shipper directly.
- Start now on planning on your outbound shipping arrangements now! Batteries are exceptionally difficult to ship.





Vehicle Entry & Exit from Pool




Vehicle Weight






Rough Seas | Coin Flip

Enter the Pacific | Gate




- Choose direction and ocean temperature

🛎 With Style


- 10 ft/3 m before/after gate



Fire torpedo for extra points


Ocean Temperatures | Bins

Mapping | Torpedoes




The panel has four different openings


- Smaller opening = more points






Good vs Bad Labels (Bounding Box)







Good vs Bad Labels (Bounding Box)




