## The American Bullfrog



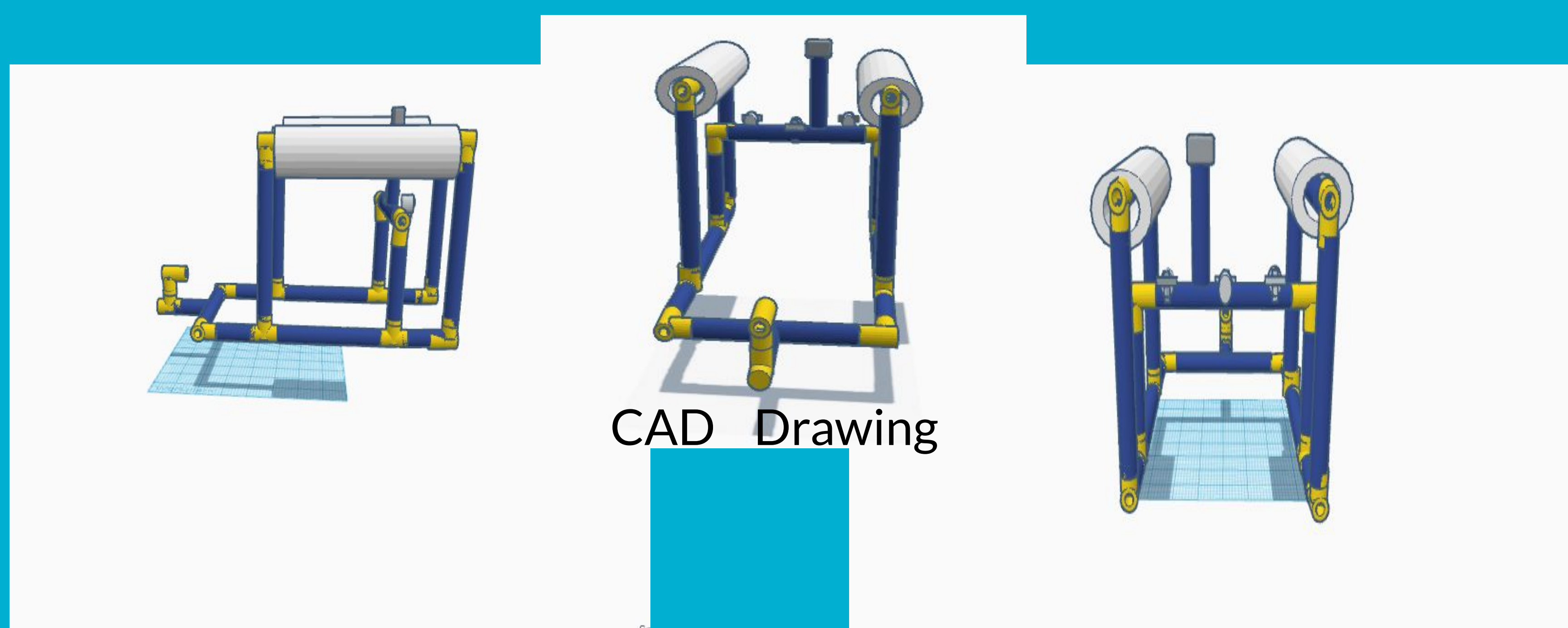
In some areas of Oklahoma the American Bullfrog is overpopulating.

This could be devastating for the ecosystem and other species. They eat other animals such as birds, turtles, and rats.

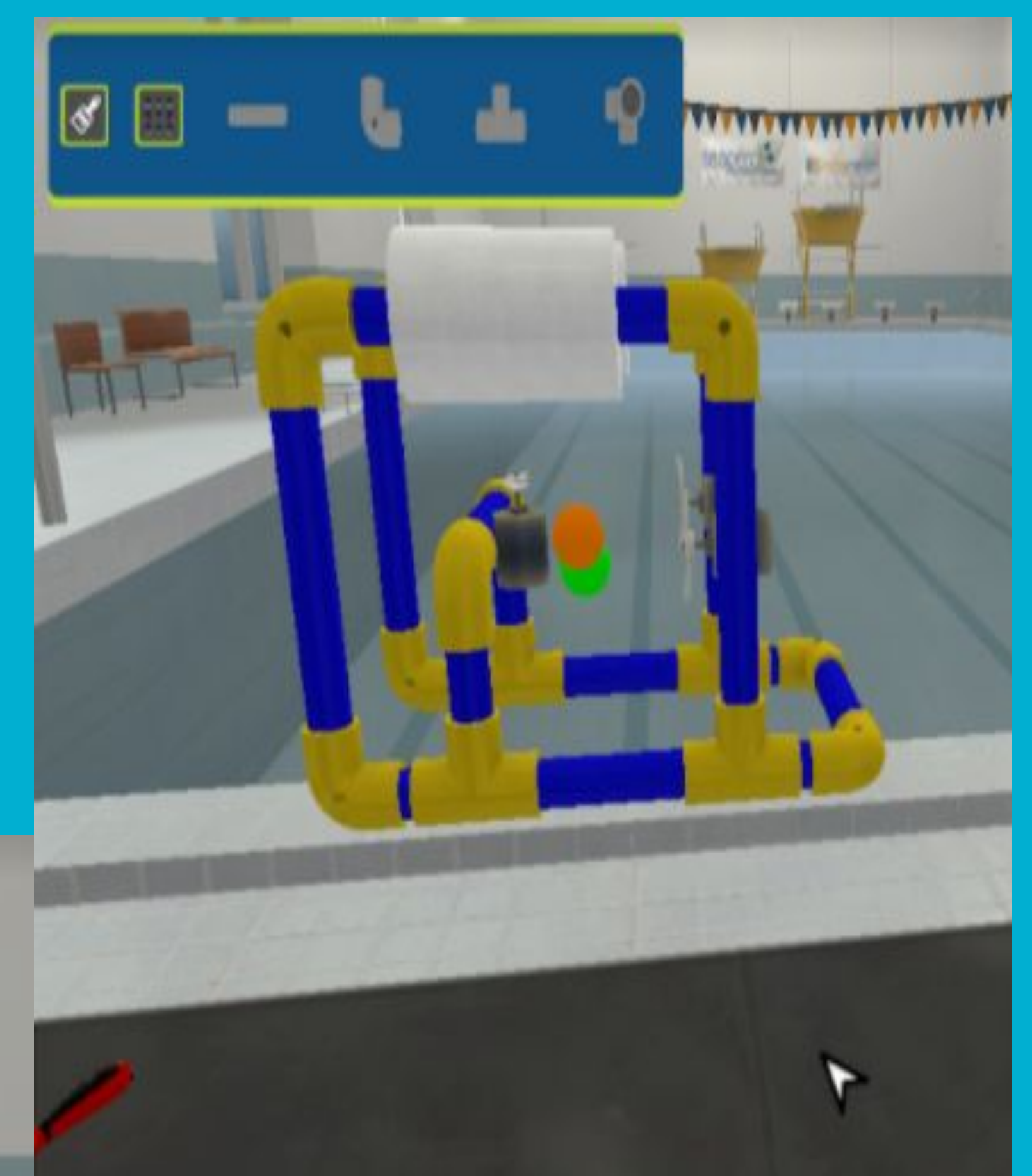
